Such items should be transported by the consumer to a designated hazardous waste facility. Unfortunately, there is no permanent hazardous waste facility in Stearns County. - auto batteries
- carburetor cleaner
- degreasers
- fuels (gasoline)
- oil filters
- used antifreeze
- used motor oil

### **Lawn & Garden**

- bug spray
- charcoal lighter fluid
- fertilizer with weed killer
- weed killer
- insect killer (includes ant/roach killers)
- pool chemicals
- rodent bait

### **Home Improvement**

- Concrete cleaner
- Driveway sealer
- Furniture stripper
- Glue w/solvents
- Latex paint
- Oil-based paint
- Paint remover and thinner
- Roofing tar
- Stain, varnish and wood preservatives

- Button batteries (in watches or hearing aids)
- Rechargeable batteries
- Drain cleaners
- Fluorescent lights
